

# CMIE ProwessIQ Installation Guide

Steps to install the latest version of Prowess IQ on your machine:

1. Visit <http://library.iiti.ac.in>
2. Go to Database link under Library Resources Then Go to CMIE ProwessIQ or directly visit the following url: <https://prowessiq.cmie.com>
3. Firstly you will have to create an account in ProwessIQ database. click to **Register** for first time registration (see Figure 1)
4. Fill all the detail with username, please ensure your account registration through official email i.e. @iiti.ac.in (see Figure 2)
5. ProwessIQ will sent a **registration mail in your email id** with login details
6. Now download ProwessIQ application from right panel "**Download**" link from following url: <https://prowessiq.cmie.com> and install on your desktop. (see Figure 3 to Figure 17)
7. During Installation step **Internet Connection Setting** in Profile 1 and 2 you will have to choose **Proxy : Authenticated** (see Figure 11)
8. Enter Proxy IP: **webproxy.indore.iiti.ac.in** and HTTP Port: **8080** in both profile. (see Figure 12 and 13)
9. Now create a shortcut ProwessIQ on your desktop.
10. Open the ProwessIQ application in your PC and login with your user name and password to start working on the database.
















